BY-LAWS

Committees

Sec. 16. By-laws Committee. The By-laws Committee shall meet at the request of the President, the Board of Directors, by call of the chairman, or by request of majority of the voting membership. They will prepare additions, deletions, and/or changes in the By-Laws. All changes shall be in writing, and be presented at a General Meeting at which time they will be read and discussed, then tabled until the following General Meeting, at which time they will again be read, discussed, and voted on. Notice of contemplated changes in the By-laws, along with a copy of the proposed change, must be sent to each Active Member at least ten (10) days prior to the next meeting after the original addition, deletion, or change has been proposed. A motion to amend or revise the By-laws requires a two-thirds (2/3) vote of Active Members present and voting.

Sec. 17. Public Relations Committee. The Public Relations Committee shall see that proper public notice is given to the general news media for all activities of the Corporation. They shall serve as a clearing house for all information that will publicize the activities of members of the Corporation as a group.

Sec. 18. ~~Ways and Means Committee~~. It shall be the duty of the Ways and Means Committee to contact various governing bodies, industries, public utilities, etc. for the purpose of seeking funds and other assets.

Sec. 19. Awards Committee. The Awards Committee will have the responsibility of selecting one (1) firefighter, who, in the general opinion, has done the most to promote the organization or who has contributed some feat or performed some action which is above and beyond the call of normal firefighting duties. They will choose some citizen, not a firefighter, who by his or her action or deeds, has contributed to the uplifting or recognition of the Corporation or associated Member Departments in a manner that benefits the community as a whole. The Awards Committee will select a fire company for recognition in their promotion of Fire Prevention in their community. They may also review and propose any individual or organization for recognition of outstanding service to the Fire Service of Erie County as situations may arise.
