You can call 911 from any phone, even an old cell phone. But remember, 911 is for real emergencies only.

When you call, the 911 operator will ask you a few questions.

They will ask you:

- What is the address of the emergency?
- What is your phone number?
- What is your name?
- What is your emergency?



The 911 operator has a list of questions to ask for each emergency. After they know where to send help, the 911 operator will ask you questions to better understand what is going on. You are their eyes and ears to the emergency, so be sure to answer their questions the best that you can.
