

** "Total Persons HUD Low/Mod Universe" population figures are based on *American Community Survey (ACS) 2006 -2010* data and not *2010 U.S. Census data*. Also, HUD's formula for calculating low-moderate income persons excludes persons residing in group quarters. The group quarter population includes persons under formally authorized supervised care or custody such as correctional institutions, nursing homes and juvenile institutions. It also includes non-institutionalized persons living in group quarters such as college dormitories, military quarters, and group homes.

CDBG NATIONAL OBJECTIVES

A project/activity funded with CDBG monies must meet one (1) of three (3) National Objectives:

- ✓ Principally benefit low-to-moderate income (LMI) persons.
- ✓ Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight.
- ✓ Meet a community development need having a particular urgency.

Of the three (3) objectives, the *primary objective* is to Principally Benefit Low-to-Moderate Income (LMI) persons. A LMI person is one whose income is no more than 80% of median income, adjusted for family size. "Principally Benefit" means that **at least 51%** of the persons to benefit from a project/activity must be LMI. Concentrations of LMI persons can be determined by census data (Tracts or Block Groups) or in most cases through income surveys, as rarely is a project benefit area coterminous with a census geographical area.
