Public meetings planned around Erie County to help shape Long Range Transportation Plan

ERIE, Pa. – The Erie Metropolitan Planning Organization is hosting five public meetings around Erie County to gather information from the community about transportation priorities, concerns and potential projects.

The meetings, along with an online survey that will run through the month of October, will help shape the 20-year Erie County Long Range Transportation Plan. Meetings are planned:

- **Thursday, Nov. 3**, 3 p.m.-6 p.m., Girard Township Building, 10140 Ridge Road, Girard.

The Erie County Long Range Transportation Plan serves as a transportation decision-making guide for Erie County elected officials, funding agencies, stakeholders and transportation partners. The plan is being developed in partnership with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation; the Erie Metropolitan Transit Authority; the Erie Regional Airport Authority; the Erie-Western Pennsylvania Port Authority; the County of Erie; the cities of Erie and Corry; township and borough officials; area transportation and planning agencies; and the residents of Erie County. This study is sponsored by Erie County Department of Planning with funding from the Federal Highway Administration, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and the County of Erie.
