ERIE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS – Regular Meeting

Mr. Fatica, Chairman, called to order a Regular Meeting of the Erie County Board of Elections at 3:45 p.m. in the Erie County Council Caucus Room.

Moving Erie 4-8 from Erie Day School to GECAC Erie West Senior Center

Mr. Leone moved to moving Erie 4-8 from Erie Day School to GECAC Erie West Senior Center, 1210 West 8th Street. Mrs. Loll seconded.

Mr. Fatica thanked Mr. Smith for securing the new polling place so rapidly since Erie Day School could no longer accommodate the elections. He noted that Mr. Smith has sent thank you letters to both agencies for their support of the election process. He called for a vote on the motion and it carried unanimously.

Certification of 2013 General Primary Ballot

Mr. Leone wished to confirm that this ballot had been proofread and Mrs. Drayer acknowledged that it had been proofread several times without any problems noted.

Mr. Fatica spoke with Mrs. Hughes regarding a press conference to outline the Voter ID rules for voters. It was agreed that this would be a good idea.

Mr. Leone moved to approve the certification of the 2013 Primary Ballot. Mrs. Loll seconded.

Mr. Cleaver inquired about why certain parts of a name are not capitalized while the first and last names are capitalized. Mrs. Drayer explained that middle names, for the sake of size, are in lower case. Otherwise, the name would extend beyond the allotted size limitations.

Mr. Fatica called for a vote on the certification of the 2013 General Primary Ballot and it carried in a unanimous vote.
