ERIE, Pa. – The Erie Metropolitan Planning Organization is inviting members of the public to weigh in on Erie County's Long Range Transportation Plan.

Members of the public are invited to review the plan and share comments at a public meeting Wednesday, February 15, 2017, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Hirt Auditorium at Blasco Library, 160 E. Front St. Residents will have the opportunity to view the draft plan and ask questions or give comments.

The public comment period will be open until March 12.
