Dahlkemper appointed by governor to Local Government Advisory Committee

Erie, PA – Erie County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper has been appointed to the Local Government Advisory Committee by Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf.

The committee, which consists of 14 members and is led by Lieutenant Governor Mike Stack, serves as a conduit for local governments to address the impact that legislation is having on their communities and to express their needs and challenges to Harrisburg.

The Local Government Advisory Committee is made up of municipal officials and other appointees from around the commonwealth. Dahlkemper is the only representative from northwestern Pennsylvania.

“It is an honor to accept this commission from Governor Wolf and advocate for our municipalities,” Dahlkemper said. “I am eager to use this platform to bring the needs of our Erie County cities, boroughs and townships to our state leadership and to be even more active and vocal in representing the interests of our county residents.”

Dahlkemper took a constitutional oath of office, as required by the commission, before Erie County Clerk of Records Kenneth Gamble on Tuesday.

The term of the commission runs concurrent to the governor’s term in office.
