## **Dahlkemper to hold public meetings on community college**

Erie, PA – Erie County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper is convening a series of public meetings about the proposed community college, in advance of County Council's expected vote June 27.

The meetings, which are free and open to the public, will feature a brief presentation detailing the community college proposal, followed by a public question-and-answer period. The public meetings are scheduled for:

- Thursday, June 15, at 7 p.m., at Union City High School, 105 Concord St.
- Monday, June 19, at 7 p.m., at Harbor Creek High School, 6375 Buffalo Road.
- Tuesday, June 20, at 7 p.m. at Girard High School, 1135 Lake St.
- Wednesday, June 21, at 7 p.m., at General McLane High School, 11761 Edinboro Road.
- Monday, June 26, at 7 p.m., at the Millcreek Township Building, 3608 W. 26th St.

"It is essential that our citizens are informed about the details of this plan," Dahlkemper said. "It is equally imperative that residents from all corners of our county have the opportunity to ask questions and share their ideas."

Dahlkemper invited representatives from Empower Erie, the group behind the community college study and plan, to present information and answer questions at the public meetings. She has encouraged members of County Council to attend as well.

County Council is expected to vote June 27 on county sponsorship of the community college.
